(Black) Comedy or a Meta-Filmic Comedy

- Black Comedy? A comic style to make the serious or taboo theme lighter for the audience. Is life and death taboo?
- Comedy with a Self-Conscious Narrative Style:
- a 1st-Person Narrator
 - who tells the story of one day in his life, with flask backs about his family, his driving career, his pursuit of his dream-girl, and his passengers (more later).
 who breaks the fourth wall to address the audience.

Professionalism: Skills vs. Tickets

"Talking about driving ... I didn't care about school grades, but if I drove badly, or failed my first driving test, I'd never live it down. Nobody judges driving by such high standards" (*The Cabbies* 2000).

- Seeing diversity of urban life
- Hearing different stories
- Meeting different passengers

Flâneur

(n.) in French

stroller, lounger, saunterer, loafer

- Associated with aimless urban wandering and observing
- "an emblematic representative of MODERNITY and the personification of contemporary urbanity" (Ferguson, 1994, p.22)



Seeing Diversity of Urban Life and Urban Views

Thefather

"Say he does 70,000 km a year, he already covered at least 2 million km. That's to say, five round trips from the earth to the moon. He's now on his sixth trip back from the moon. As long as he doesn't hit a meteorite, he should reach earth by the end of the year."

Hearing and Collecting different stories happening in the city

"My dad once told me, people tend to confide their secrets to strangers they'll never meet again." \rightarrow Loneliness of urban dwellers

("The Cabbie", 2000)

Types:

- Family Problems 1) husband's affair; 2) father's affair, 9) brother "murderer"
- Social Indifference 3) desire for anonymity 6) genetic determinism
- Sexual Problems & Desires 4) problem with erection, 7) flasher 8) asking for a date
- 5) kid's dinosaur fantasy



















Meeting different passengers and categorizing them

"Whenever passengers get in, I try to guess what they're like. Will they pay? Will they give me a little extra? Will they tell me to keep the change? I'm mostly right about them."

\rightarrow Oberservation

 \rightarrow Categorization – Those giving more, the stingy types, The borrowers, the robber...

V. Taxi Triangle on the Road: A. Taxi Driver's Family – experienced with death

The Su Family: Father

- Su Zhou (蘇周)
- Taxi driver/The boss of the taxi company
- Mediater→ deal with compensation claims
- Sophisticated → eat after seeing You at work
 → friendship with the police
- Familar w/ death and facing car accidents





The Su Family: Mother

- You Xi-zi (游希子)
- Coroner→ stereotypes/ a good observer
- Familiar with death when dealing corpses
- An ordiary mother



This pig was half dead when it was killed

You use gloves at work, don't you?

The Su Family: Mother & Father

- Emotional
- Love (through their actions in the daily life)



The Su Family: Sister

- Chemistry lover
- Familiar to danger \rightarrow chemical explosion





The Su Family: Sister

- Sister's husband: chemical engineer
- Topics over Dinner Table (cf. Jingwen's visit)
- \rightarrow occupation// food pollution or car accidents
